

## Morland Area 100 Club Lottery Rules

1. The “100 Club” will be operated under the Gambling Act 2005, which deals with Small Society Lotteries. The promoter will be Morland School PTA of Morland Area Primary School.
2. Morland School P.T.A. Committee reserves the right to amend the rules of the 100 Club as and when necessary. Members will be informed of any changes in writing.
3. All profits made by the 100 Club will go to Morland P.T.A. and will be used to support Morland Area Primary School.
4. Members of the 100 Club must be over the age of 16 years by law.
5. Morland School P.T.A. will aim to enrol 100 members into the Club. In the event of there being more or less than 100 members, the Club will issue the required number of draw numbers to satisfy demand. Prizes will be awarded pro-rata based on the actual number of members in the draw.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Prize = 40% of funds raised per month
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize = 20% “
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize = 15% “
  - 25% donation to school funds
6. The subscription will be £3.00 per month, per number, payable by standing order or cheque where absolutely necessary.
7. The 100 Club year will run from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> June. All annual payments should be made on the first working day of July.
8. New members may join the Club at any point in the year. Payments will be pro-rata for that year.
9. On receipt of payment an applicant will be allocated a draw number. Individuals can apply and pay for more than one draw number.
10. The draw will take place during the first school week of each month. Winners will be notified by email or telephone within 7 days. The results will be available for inspection and published in The North Westmorland News (parish newsletter).
11. The draw will be made by a school pupil in assembly and overseen by a member of staff.
