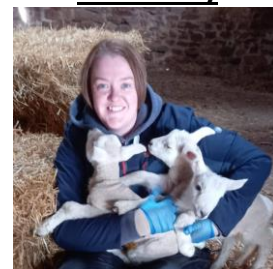
- C1 and C2 - Refresh outdoor areas
