9.00am - 3.00pm Monday - Friday through the summer holidays.

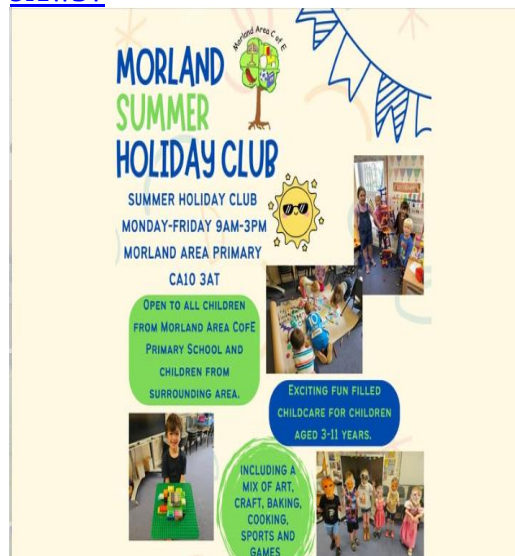

Pupil Premium/Free School Meals funding

Changes to eligibility from September 2026

From the start of the 2026 to 2027 school year, the Department for Education (DfE) is expanding eligibility for free school meals.

What is changing

From September 2026, all children living in households that receive Universal Credit will be entitled to free school meals, regardless of earnings.

The current Universal Credit income limit (£7,400) will be removed. You will still need to apply once the new national system is live.
